Criteria and Nomination Requirements

Up-and-Coming Professional

This award focuses on a documented successful career of an up-and-coming individual in the area of auxiliary services who is known for their innovative, meaningful contributions to the improvement of their profession and the efficiency of their institution. Nominees should:

- Be outstanding professionals who have clearly displayed a very high level of dedication to pursuing ethics, self-improvement, job improvement, job efficiency and sound management skills.
- Have spent at least three (3) years in auxiliary services
- Have exhibited good leadership and support skills in campus auxiliary services while showing great enthusiasm for the exchange of ideas and systems among the membership of the association

Outstanding Collaboration/Partnership

This award is presented to a unique, innovative or distinctive partnership that benefits the University / College, its respective community, and Business Partner(s), if applicable. This award will be presented to the best or most outstanding partnership or collaboration within or between:

- Universities or Colleges
- Departments or units within a University or College
- University / College departments and students
- University / College and Business Partners
- Any combination of the above

Lifetime Achievement

The Lifetime Achievement Award shall be given annually to an individual who has excelled in the field of auxiliary services. The recipient should be a role model for aspiring auxiliary service professionals and the recipient's actions must have benefited both their institution and higher education. All nominees should have an extensive list of professional achievements, strong management skills and a history of providing leadership to their institution and the profession.

*All nomination forms must be accompanied by a written narrative to guide the committee in making the best selection possible.
